## SENATE BILL No. 341

By Legislative Post Audit Committee

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9 AN ACT concerning the division of post audit; relating to the school 10 district audit team; amending K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 46-1132 and repealing 11 the existing section. 1213Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 46-1132 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 46-1132. (a) In order to assist the legislature in the gathering of 16information which is necessary for the legislature's consideration when 17meeting its constitutional duties to: (1) Provide for intellectual, educational, vocational and scientific improvement in public schools established 1819and maintained by the state; and (2) make suitable provision for the fi-20nance of educational interests of the state, the school district audit team 21established by K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 46-1130, and amendments thereto, shall 22 conduct performance audits and shall monitor school district funding and 23 other oversight issues through audit work as directed by the 2010 com-24 mission Except as specifically provided by this section, school district performance audits shall be conducted in the manner provided by the 2526 legislative post audit act. The scope of such audit work may not be mod-27ified by the legislative post audit committee legislative post audit 28 committee. 29 (b) The legislative post auditor may solicit school-related audit topics 30 from the house and senate committees on education, the state department 31of education and other education-related sources. The topics for school 32 district performance audits may include: 33 (1)The accuracy of school expenditures, reports or other 34 information; 35 how school districts use the funding received from the state; (2)36 the relationship between school funding levels and costs; (3)37 (4)the weights of various education program components or the level 38 of equity achieved by the funding system; 39 (5)whether funding levels for education programs or students are 40 keeping up with the actual costs school districts report; 41(6)the basis for changes in school district costs; 42the reasonableness of the amount and type of actual or budgeted (7)43 expenditures compared with historical costs or with costs of other

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2 (8) options for modifying the school funding formula;

(9) other finance issues identified as needing further study;

(10) whether a school district has adequate operating or administrative procedures and fiscal controls and whether it is efficiently managed;

tive procedures and fiscal controls and whether it is efficiently managed;
(11) best practices or innovative procedures, practices or controls operating within any school districts that could present opportunities for
other school districts to operate more efficiently; and

9 (12) any other topic as directed by the 2010 commission legislative 10 post audit committee.

(c) In accordance with and subject to the scope of a school district
performance audit approved by the commission as provided by this scetion legislative post audit committee, the legislative post auditor shall determine which school districts are to be audited based on the audit topics
included and the resources available to conduct the audit.

(d) The provisions of subsection (g) of K.S.A. 46-1106, and amendments thereto, shall apply to any audit or audit work conducted pursuant
to this section.

(e) Any firm which develops information in the course of conducting
a school district performance audit which the legislative post auditor is
required to report under subsection (d) of K.S.A. 46-1106, and amendments thereto, immediately shall report such information to the legislative
post auditor. The legislative post auditor shall make the report required
in subsection (d) of K.S.A. 46-1106, and amendments thereto.

(f) In conducting any school district performance audit and subject to the limitations of the budget of the division and appropriations therefor, the legislative post auditor may enter into contracts for consultants as the legislative post auditor deems necessary for any school district performance audit conducted under this section.

30 (g) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the legislative 31 post audit act.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 46-1132 is hereby repealed.
