10 AN ACT concerning county officers; relating to undersheriffs; amending 11 K.S.A. 19-804a and repealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 19-804a is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-14 15 804a. Except in those counties operating under the provisions of the consolidated law enforcement act, whenever a vacancy occurs in the office 16 of sheriff of any county, the undersheriff of such county shall in all things 17 18 execute the office of sheriff until a sheriff shall be appointed by the governor in the manner provided by law for filling vacancies in the office of 19 20 member of house of representatives. When there shall be no sheriff or 21 undersheriff in an organized any county, it shall be the duty of the county 22 clerk to exercise all the powers and duties of the sheriff of his such clerk's 23 county until a sheriff be elected or qualified; and when. When the sheriff 24 for any cause shall be committed to the jail of his such sheriff's county, 25 the county clerk shall be keeper thereof during the time the sheriff shall 26 remain a prisoner therein. 27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 19-804a is hereby repealed. 28
