On and after July 1, 2010, no municipality shall adopt or en-19 force any ordinance, order, code, standard or rule requiring the installa-20tion of a multi-purpose residential fire protection sprinkler system or any 21other fire sprinkler protection system in any residential structure. Nothing 22 in this section shall prohibit any person from voluntarily installing a multi-23 purpose residential fire protection sprinkler system or any other fire 24 sprinkler protection system in a residential structure. 25Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 26 publication in the statute book.
