9 AN ACT concerning the secretary of corrections; relating to inmate ac-
10 cess to information containing personally identifying information.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. (a) On or before August 1, 2010, the secretary of correc-
14 tions shall promulgate rules and regulations to protect the privacy of Kan-
15 sans by prohibiting the sharing of information containing personally iden-
16 tifying information with inmates.

17 (b) As used in this section, “personally identifying information” in-
18 cludes, but is not limited to, birthdates, social security numbers, taxpayer
19 identification numbers, driver’s license numbers, account numbers of ac-
20 tive financial accounts, and any other information the secretary deems
21 appropriate to protect the privacy of Kansans.

22 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
23 publication in the statute book.
