Committee on **Elections and Governmental Organization** recommends **HB 2019** be passed.

Committee on **Elections and Governmental Organization** recommends **HB 2002** be amended on page 1, in line 17, before the period by inserting “which shall be composed of seven members”; in line 22, by striking the third comma and inserting “and to”; in line 23, by striking all after “resources”; in line 24, by striking “members.”; in line 30, by striking all after the period; by striking all in lines 31 through 35; in line 36, by striking all before “The”; and the bill be passed as amended.

HB 2107, An act concerning insurance; relating to security deposits in financial institutions; amending K.S.A. 40-229a and repealing the existing section, by Committee on Insurance and Financial Institutions.

HB 2108, An act concerning insurance sold on military reservations; authorizing adoption of rules and regulations; amending K.S.A. 40-250 and repealing the existing section, by Committee on Insurance and Financial Institutions.

HB 2120. An act relating to drivers' licenses; concerning farm permits; amending K.S.A. 8-296 and repealing the existing section, by Committee on Transportation.

HB 2121. An act concerning motor vehicles; relating to drivers' licenses; requiring van endorsement for certain vehicles; amending K.S.A. 8-234a, 8-234b and 8-238 and K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 8-240 and repealing the existing sections, by Committee on Transportation.

HB 2122. An act concerning school districts; relating to school finance; relating to the high enrollment weighting and the low enrollment weighting; amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 72-6412 and 72-6442b and repealing the existing sections, by Committee on Education.

HB 2123. An act concerning school districts; relating to transportation of certain pupils; amending K.S.A. 72-1046b and repealing the existing section, by Representative Aurand.

HB 2124. An act pertaining to the Kansas department of revenue; concerning the division of vehicles; prohibiting certain contracts relating to drivers' license renewal; prohibiting certain actions relating to renewal of vehicle registration, by Representative Olson.

HB 2125. An act concerning insurance; providing coverage for hearing aids; amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 40-2,103 and 40-19c09 and repealing the existing sections, by Representative Kiegerl.
