## **CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT Senate Concurrent Resolution NO. 1623**

As Agreed to May 3, 2002

## Brief \*

SCR 1623 requests the Insurance Commissioner to form a task force to study the use of insurance scoring reports within the insurance industry and the need for additional regulation of that activity, if any.

The Conference Committee accedes to the House amendments and further agrees to amend the concurrent resolution as it designates the membership on the task force. The Conference Committee amendments:

- Change the number of members to 15;
- Reinsert the appointment of a member representing a foreign property and casualty insurance company from a list submitted by the Kansas Association of Property and Casualty Insurance Companies;
- Strike the appointment of a person representing foreign stock insurance companies appointed from a list submitted by the American Insurance Association in favor of a person representing a (undesignated) property and casualty insurance company from a list submitted by the Association; and
- Strike the appointment of a person representing a foreign mutual insurance company appointed from a list submitted by the National Association of Independent Insurers in favor of a person representing a (undesignated) property and casualty insurance company from a list submitted by that Association.
