**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON
HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 74**

As Recommended by House Committee on
Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

House Sub. for SB 74 sets the deadline for the filing of nomination petition and declaration for members of the Kansas Legislature to June 10 in any year in which legislative districts are reapportioned. Filing deadlines for offices of representatives in the United States Congress would remain the same as current law.

Background

SB 74, as amended by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs, allows tribal law enforcement agencies and officers, when specifically requested to assist state, county, or city law enforcement agencies and officers, to be considered to be a part of the office or agency being assisted. The tribal agency or officer would have the same powers, duties, and immunities of the state, county, or city agency during the period of time in which the tribal enforcement agency or officer is providing assistance.

The House Committee on Federal and State Affairs deleted the provisions in SB 74 and replaced them with provisions dealing with the filing deadlines.
