SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 604

As Recommended by Senate Committee on
Ways and Means

Brief*

SB 604 would appropriate \$30,000 State General Fund for FY 2003 to the Department of Health and Environment for a Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Farmer's Market Nutrition Program. The appropriation would provide WIC participants with vouchers to be used to purchase fresh produce at farmer's markets. The bill contains a requirement that there would be no expenditures until a federal grant of \$70,000 is received.

Background

The bill was introduced by the Senate Committee on Agriculture. A representative of Kansas Rural Center testified in favor of the bill. There were no opponents to the bill appearing before the Committee.
