# SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1615

## As Amended by Senate Committee on Agriculture

#### Brief\*

SCR 1615 would urge the United States Congress to include in its current work on the farm bill a requirement that would result in country of origin labeling of certain beef, lamb, pork, farm-raised fish, and perishable agricultural commodities or peanuts when its country of origin is the United States.

### **Background**

This concurrent resolution was introduced by the 2001 Special Committee on Agriculture. The Senate Committee on Agriculture amended the bill to ask that the Congress require that certain agricultural products be labeled as to country of origin when its origin is the United States. Other amendments were technical in nature.
