SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1622

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Agriculture

Brief*

SCR 1622 would urge the University of Kansas School of Law to establish and maintain an agriculture law clinic to further develop and foster expertise and experience in agriculture law which would provide qualified law students and legal professionals to meet the legal needs of agriculture producers in the state.

Background

The Dean of the University of Kansas School of Law appeared in support of the resolution. The Dean indicated that there were very few law schools which train lawyers to represent agricultural interests and agricultural clients. He indicated that there is real opportunity for Kansas to take the lead in this area and to prepare generations of lawyers to promote and advance the interests of the Kansas agricultural industry. There were no other conferees on the resolution.
