SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2670

As Recommended by House Committee on Local Government

Brief*

HB 2670 provides that a township officer who is also an employee of the township must abstain from voting for or participating in any motion to increase the compensation, salary, or benefits to be paid to the person as an employee.

Background

The sponsor said the bill was in response to a letter from the Attorney General to a state senator which said no state law prohibited a township officer from voting on motions to increase their pay as a township employee.

The bill has no fiscal impact.
