## SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2681

## As Amended by House Committee on Appropriations

### Brief\*

HB 2681 amends KSA 39-923 relating to licensure of adult care facilities. It increased the number of individuals allowed in a "home plus" facility from five to eight and allows an adult care home to convert a portion of one wing of the facility to a "home plus" facility as long as the separate licensure areas remain contiguous.

# Background

No opposition was presented to HB 2681, however, the Kansas Association of Home and Services for the Aging recommended amending the original bill to include language that would make the licensure areas with a facility contiguous. The amendment was adopted by the Committee.

The Department of Health and Environment indicates that HB 2681 will have no fiscal impact and will require no changes to existing administrative procedure.
