SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2751

As Amended by House Committee on Judiciary

Brief*

HB 2751 amends the identity theft statute by removing the economic benefit requirement and replacing it with any benefit.

The penalty for a non-economic benefit would be a class A misdemeanor.

Background

The legislator who requested the bill testified in support of the measure. An attorney from Abilene and a delegate from the Consumer Data Information Association also appeared in support of the bill. In addition, a detective from the Johnson County Sheriff's Office appeared in favor of the bill. A letter of support was received from the Emporia Police Department.

The fiscal note indicates the fiscal effect of the bill, as drafted, cannot be predicted at this time.
