## **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2792**

## As Recommended by House Committee on Transportation

## Brief\*

HB 2792 concerns approval of lighting plans for highways and bridges by the Kansas Corporation Commission. The bill would repeal KSA 68-163, which requires utilities to file and receive approval from the Kansas Corporation Commission before implementing plans for lighting to be installed on any road, highway, or bridge.

# **Background**

HB 2792 was supported by Westar Energy. The conferee representing Westar explained that only one county in Kansas complies with KSA 68-163. He said the law creates unnecessary paperwork and delays in street lighting projects. He further noted that under current practice, approval is tied to compliance with the associated tariff and does not involve an actual review of the plans. He noted all tariffs have been approved by the Commission and that compliance can be verified through periodic reviews.

There were no other conferees.

There would be no fiscal effect as a result of this bill.
