SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2825

As Amended by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

HB 2825 would amend the Public Employer-Employee Relations Act (PEERA) by requiring, in the case of state employees only, that the factfinder's report resulting from an impasse in labor negotiations be binding upon the state and its agencies. Under current law, the factfinder's report is not binding on either party.

As introduced, HB 2825 would have extended this new procedure to the state and any covered local units of government. The House Committee amended the bill to limit the new procedure only to the state and its agencies.

Background

Testifying in support of the bill were representatives of the Kansas State Troopers Association and the State Lodge of the Fraternal Order of Police.

Testifying in opposition to the bill were representatives of the Wichita Public Schools, the Kansas Association of School Boards, the City of Wichita, and the Kansas League of Municipalities.

The fiscal note indicates that, according to the Department of Human Resources, HB 2825 would have no immediate fiscal effect on the state, but if there were an increase in the use of factfinders, additional funding would be needed. However, the extent of that additional funding is unclear.
