### SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2901

# As Recommended by House Committee on Higher Education

### Brief\*

HB 2901 authorizes Kansas State University to exchange approximately 37,100 square feet of University-owned property for property owned by the Kansas State University Foundation.

## Background

The bill was introduced by the Legislative Educational Planning Committee at the request of Kansas State University and the Board of Regents. A representative of Kansas State University testified that the Kansas State University Foundation is constructing a new alumni center on the University's campus and would like to own the property on which the building would stand. The Foundation would provide the University with land in the K-State Research Park in exchange for the University's property. A representative of the Board of Regents also testified in support of the bill. No opponents to the bill testified.

The fiscal note on the bill from the Division of the Budget indicates the properties exchanged would be of equal value.
