## SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2367

As Amended by House Committee of the Whole

## Brief\*

HB 2367, as amended, would permit the Secretary of Administration to use inspection services of a local political subdivision to inspect a state capital improvement project, with the concurrence of the state agency which owns the property. Currently, employees of the Division of Facilities Management must perform all inspections.

## Background

The House Committee amended the bill to require concurrence of the agency which owns the property in question before local inspection services could be utilized.

A representative of the Division of Facilities Management of the Department of Administration testified in support of the bill and proposed the amendment, at the request of the Board of Regents. A representative of the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials appeared in opposition to the bill.

The House Committee of the Whole amendment was technical in nature.

The fiscal note submitted by the Division of the Budget indicated that the bill will have only a "negligible" fiscal impact.
