Brief*

SB 235 would allow a city to extend the amount of time for remediation of an environmentally contaminated area under the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Act to 30 years upon the approval of the Board of County Commissioners and the local board of education. Current law limits the amount of time to 20 years.

Conference Committee Action

The Conference Committee adopted the House Committee on Federal and State Affairs amendments to SB 405.
