SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 337

As Amended by Senate Committee on
Judiciary

Brief*

SB 337 repeals the crime of hypnotic exhibition, defined as “giving for entertainment any instruction, exhibition, demonstration or performance in which hypnosis is used or attempted; or permitting oneself to be exhibited for entertainment while in a state of hypnosis.”

Hypnotic exhibition is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not to exceed \$50.

The Senate Committee amended the bill to make it effective in the *Kansas Register*.

Background

The bill was supported by a Larned business owner and the Mayor of Larned.

The bill has no fiscal impact.
