SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2603

As Recommended by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

Brief*

HB 2603 deals with criminal procedures, specifically an offender's criminal history classifications, to clarify that a violation of an act under KSA 2003 Supp. 21-3442 (involuntary manslaughter while driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs) will count as a person felony for criminal history purposes.

Background

Support for the bill was expressed on behalf of the Kansas County and District Attorneys Association as a result of the recent Court of Appeals decision in *State v. Manbeck*, No. 89,303.
