SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2675

As Amended by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

Brief*

HB 2675, as amended, authorizes expenditures from the State General Fund and various special revenue funds for the payment of specific claims against the State of Kansas. Agencies affected by the bill include: the Department of Revenue; the Kansas Highway Patrol; the Kansas Bureau of Investigation; the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services; Lansing Correctional Facility; Ellsworth Correctional Facility; El Dorado Correctional Facility; Topeka Correctional Facility; Hutchinson Correctional Facility; the Department of Corrections; and the Attorney General.

Background

The House Committee amended the bill to add two claims for payments of expired warrants. Other House Committee amendments were technical in nature.

The House Committee of the Whole amended the bill to add one claim for a refund of a sales tax overpayment.

The Senate Committee added three amendments to the bill: two claims authorize the Attorney General to pay for services where the invoice was submitted in an untimely manner; and the Board of Nursing was directed to reimburse a claimant for attorney fees and related expenses incurred in an application for a nursing license.

The bill, as amended by the Senate Committee authorizes total expenditures of \$103,844, which includes \$1,932 from operating accounts of the State General Fund, and \$102,911 from other sources.
