SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2364

As Amended by House Committee on
Appropriations

Brief*

HB 2364 would authorize the Board of Regents to sell certain parcels of land on behalf of Kansas State University and the University of Kansas.

Background

Kansas State University wishes to conduct three land transactions:

- ! A parcel of land in Riley County to be sold to Meadowlark Hills Retirement Community;
- ! Approximately 200 acres of land in Kingman County at Cheney Reservoir previously used for horticulture research; and
- ! A parcel of land and a building in Pottawatomie County previously used for storage.

The University of Kansas wishes to sell a parcel of land in Lawrence purchased in the 1800s. This parcel is not adjacent to any other land owned by the University or the Endowment Association.

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Higher Education. Representatives from Kansas State University and the University of Kansas presented written testimony to the House Committee in favor of the bill. There were no conferees appearing in

opposition to the bill. The House Committee's amendments were technical in nature to clarify the specific parcels of land to be sold.
