SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 325

As Recommended by Senate Committee
on Agriculture

Brief*

SB 325 would abolish the Aquaculture Advisory Council.

Background

This bill was introduced by the Legislative Coordinating Council. At the hearing on the bill, the only conferee was a representative of the Kansas Department of Agriculture. This conferee indicated that the agency was a proponent of the bill. The conferee noted that the Aquaculture Advisory Council was established in 1992, but that the industry currently had no interest in the continuation of the Council. The conferee stated that the agency would continue to support the aquaculture industry in the state and assist the Department of Commerce in what way possible to promote and market aquaculture products from the State of Kansas.

The fiscal note indicates there would be no fiscal impact.
