SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 153

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Education

Brief*

SB 153 would allow the three school districts in Stafford County – USD 349 Stafford, USD 350 St. John-Hudson, and USD 351 Macksville – to share equally in the assessed valuation of real property and improvements of a proposed ethanol or biodiesel plant to be built in Stafford County. This assignment of assessed valuation to each of the districts would be made for purposes of calculating state aid to the districts.

Background

At the hearing on the bill, Senator Teichman and a representative of the Kansas National Education Association testified on behalf of the bill. There were no opponents to the bill.

In the fiscal note, the Kansas State Department of Education indicated that the bill would have a negligible effect on the distribution of state aid to the three affected districts.
