SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1606

As Introduced and Referred to Senate Committee of the Whole

Brief*

SCR 1606 would designate the region from Manhattan to the Kansas City metropolitan area as the KC Animal Health Corridor and recognize the value and economic benefits of the animal health industry throughout the state. The concurrent resolution notes that thirty-seven global or U.S. animal health companies have their headquarters in this region and that a total of 120 companies have a presence in the area. The concurrent resolution would recognize that the retention and growth of these companies will create quality jobs and wealth for the state.

Background

This resolution was introduced by Senator Jordan and referred directly to the Senate Committee of the Whole.
