SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2159

As Recommended by House Committee on Education

Brief*

HB 2159 would allow school districts to conduct a second count of students on February 20, 2008, and February 20, 2009. This second count is permitted for students who are dependents of full-time active members of the military service or dependents of the military reserve who have been ordered to active duty for at least 30 consecutive days. This enrollment count is the basis for calculating districts' state aid.

Background

At the hearing on the bill, representatives of USD 260 – Derby, USD 475 – Geary County, USD 383 – Manhattan and Ogden, and USD 207 – Ft. Leavenworth supported the bill. There were no opponents to the bill.

The fiscal note estimated an impact of \$4,021,200 in state aid.
