### SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2299

### As Recommended by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

# **Brief\***

HB 2299 would prohibit any city or county from enacting any ordinance or resolution which creates a domestic partner registry.

# Background

Representative Kinzer, appeared as a proponent for the bill. Appearing as opponents of the bill were three representatives of the Kansas Equality Coalition, a resident of Lawrence, a resident of Wichita, and the owner of Maceli's Catering. In addition, written only testimony in opposition to the bill was presented from the League of Women Voters of Kansas and the City Manager of Lawrence, Kansas.

The fiscal note indicates that the League of Kansas Municipalities and the Kansas Association of Counties indicate passage of the bill would have no fiscal effect on local government.
