# SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2374

### As Recommended by House Committee on Transportation

### **Brief\***

HB 2374 would allow the Director of Vehicles of the Kansas Department of Revenue to provide an employer with an employee's motor vehicle driving record if the employee is required to drive in the course of his or her job. The records would be used by the employer to ensure driver behavior, performance, or safety.

## Background

HB 2374 was supported by representatives of Explore Information Services and the Kansas Department of Revenue. Written testimony in support of the bill also was submitted by J.B. Hunt Transport, Inc. No one appeared in opposition of the bill.

The Department of Revenue indicates that the bill would increase the number of motor vehicle driving record searches it conducts each year. The Department, however, is unable to estimate the number of employers who would conduct motor vehicle driving record searches or the amount of additional fees it would collect. The Department indicates that the costs associated with performing additional motor vehicle driving record searches would be negligible and could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.
