Corrected SESSION OF 2007

SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2398

As Recommended by House Committee on Education

Brief*

Sub. for HB 2398 would require each school district board to adopt policies to limit the exposure of students and faculty to blood, other bodily fluids, and other potentially infectious materials. The adopted policies would be required to meet or exceed the Kansas Department of Health and Environment's current Exposure Control Plan. The bill also would require school districts to provide training for students and faculty on the policy.

Background

At the hearing on the bill, Representative Horst testified on behalf of the bill. There were no opponents to the bill.

The House Education Committee amended the bill to require that a school district adopt a policy that meets or exceeds the current Exposure Control Plan of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.

The fiscal note estimated that the bill would have no fiscal impact.
