SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 514

As Amended by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

SB 514, as amended, would allow the Emergency Medical Services Board to grant a temporary variance from identified regulations when a literal application or enforcement of the regulations would result in serious hardship and the relief granted would not result in an unreasonable risk to the public interest, safety, or welfare.

Background

Robert Waller, Chief Administrator, Board of Emergency Medical Services, spoke as a proponent to the bill. No opponents testified in opposition to the bill.

The fiscal note indicate that the Board of Emergency Medical Services would absorb any additional expenditures recently from passage of SB 514.
