SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 614

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Utilities

Brief*

SB 614 would amend existing law regarding notification required to be provided by the Kansas Electric Transmission Authority (KETA) regarding facilities or services contemplated by the Authority. The bill would clarify that the 90-day time period for private entities to respond to a notification from KETA begins when that notice is published in the *Kansas Register*.

The Committee recommended that the bill be placed on the Consent Calendar.

Background

The bill was introduced at the request of the Kansas Electric Transmission Authority.

Senator Emler explained the bill. No testimony was presented regarding the bill.

The Senate Committee recommended the bill be adopted as introduced.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates passage of the bill would have no effect on the state budget.
