SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2643

As Amended by Senate Committee on Judiciary

Brief*

HB 2643, as amended, would clarify that a garnishee must serve an answer within ten days after service of an Order of Garnishment, unless service is obtained by serving the Commissioner of Insurance, then the garnishee would have 40 days to answer or otherwise respond.

Background

Randy Hearrell, Kansas Judicial Council, spoke in favor of the bill in the House Committee on Judiciary. There was no testimony in opposition to the bill.

Randy Hearrell, Kansas Judicial Council, spoke in favor of the bill in the Senate Committee on Judiciary. There was no testimony in opposition to the bill.

The Senate Committee amended the bill to clarify that service of an Order of Garnishment on the Commissioner of Insurance would require the garnishee to answer or otherwise respond within 40 days.

The fiscal note indicates no fiscal impact.
