SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2702

As Recommended by House Committee on Health and Human Services

Brief*

HB 2702 would make two changes to the Dental Practices Act. It would allow dental hygienists who are licensed in other states to provide clinical education at meetings of the Kansas State Dental Association or other dental organization approved by the Kansas Dental Board, and would require out-of-state applicants who seek licensure by credentials to meet the 24-month continuing education requirement applicable to Kansas licensees.

The Committee recommended the bill be placed on the consent calendar.

Background

The bill was introduced at the request of the Kansas Dental Board, whose representative testified in support of the bill. There was no testimony in opposition to the bill at the Committee hearing.

The House Committee adopted the introduced version of the bill.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates passage of the bill would have no effect on the state budget.
