SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2924

As Recommended by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

HB 2924 would designate March 19 of each year as "Civilian Conservation Corps Day." The bill requests that the Governor issue an annual proclamation calling on state and local officials to display the United States flag on all state and school buildings, and the people of the state to display the flag at their homes, lodges, churches, places of business, and other suitable places, on that day. Finally, public and private organizations and individuals in this state would be urged to take appropriate action on this day to properly recognize the contributions that men and women working in Civilian Conservation Corps projects made to the welfare of the State of Kansas as part of President Franklin D. Roosevelt's "New Deal" legislation signed into law on March 19, 1933.

Background

The only conferee was Representative Don Dahl, who requested the legislation and appeared as a proponent.

The fiscal note indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect.
