SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 187

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

Brief*

SB 187 would allow the State Fire Marshal to appoint an employee of a state educational institution to inspect buildings in conjunction with the State Fire Marshal's Office.

Background

SB 187 was introduced by the Senate Committee on Ways and Means.

At the hearing on the bill, proponents included: Dan McLaughlin, Kansas State Fire Marshal's Office, and written testimony from Eric King, Director of Facilities at the Kansas Board of Regents.

There were no opponents to the bill.

The fiscal note attached to SB 187 states that there would be no fiscal effect to either the State Fire Marshal's Office or the Kansas Board of Regents.
