### SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 268

## As Recommended by Senate Committee on Ethics and Elections

### Brief\*

SB 268 would allow certain federal services voters (*i.e.*, those residing outside the United States or those who are members of the United States armed forces or a spouse or dependent of a member of the armed forces and a qualified elector who cannot vote timely by mail) to apply for registration and an absentee ballot by electronic mail.

# **Background**

Representatives of the Office of the Secretary of State and the Riley County Commissioners testified in favor of the bill. No opponents testified.

According to the fiscal note, passage of the bill would have no effect on the state budget.
