SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 308

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

Brief*

SB 308 would amend existing law in regard to the State General Fund administrative services fee charged to agency fee funds. Under existing law, fee funded agencies transfer 20.0 percent of the revenues generated to the State General Fund, up to \$200,000. The bill would raise this limitation from \$200,000 to \$350,000.

Background

There were no proponents on the bill.

A representative of the Board of Emergency Medical Services testified as a neutral party.

Opponents to the bill included representatives from the Board of Nursing, the Kansas State Nursing Association, the Board of Healing Arts, the Kansas Bankers Association, and the Kansas Medical Society.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates that passage of this bill would result in an increase to the State General Fund of \$1,352,805.
