SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2067

As Recommended by House Committee on Commerce and Labor

Brief*

HB 2067 would no longer require the Secretary of State to be the custodian of the permanent records of the Kansas Home Inspector Registration Board.

Background

Kathy Sachs, Secretary of State's Office, testified as a proponent on HB 2067. She stated in her testimony that the bill passed in the 2008 Legislative Session which created the Kansas Home Inspector Registration Board erroneously listed the Secretary of State as the custodian of the Board's permanent records. She said that in the same paragraph of the bill, the Secretary of the Board also was named as custodian of the records.

The fiscal note indicates that passage of HB 2067 would have no fiscal effect.
