CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT BRIEF HOUSE BILL NO. 2691

As Agreed to April 29, 2010

Brief*

HB 2691 would statutorily add the Home Inspectors Registration Board to the list of agencies that file their budget estimates on a biennial basis with the Division of the Budget. Each agency listed may file adjustments to such agency's budget that was approved by the Legislature during a prior fiscal year.

Conference Committee Action

In Conference Committee, the Senate conferees agreed to remove the Senate amendment to the bill. Which would have reduced the amount of liability for those conducting home inspections from \$10,000 to \$2,000.

Background

The Home Inspectors Registration Board was originally created during the 2008 Legislature in HB 2315. Statutes related to the Board were subsequently amended by 2009 Senate Sub. for HB 2260. There were no opponents or proponents on this bill. The Committee passed the bill out favorably and recommended it be put on the Consent Calendar. The fiscal note prepared by the Division of Budget indicates that the bill will have no fiscal impact.
