SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 566

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

SB 566 would require the Kansas Commission on Veterans' Affairs to hold bimonthly meetings.

Background

Senator Mark Taddiken was the only conferee testifying on the bill. He stated that currently the Commission is required to meet 12 times a year, but if SB 566 is enacted the Commission only would have to meet only six times a year.

The Senate Committee placed the bill on the Consent Calendar.

According to the fiscal note, the reduced number of meetings would save the Commission \$4,774 from the State General Fund.
