SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 579

As Amended by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

SB 579 would exempt a clearly identified law enforcement motor vehicle from the window tinting restrictions which disallow a motor vehicle to have a one-way glass or any sun screening device where the total light transmission would be less than 35 percent.

Background

Proponents of the bill included a representative of the Kansas Association of Chiefs of Police, Kansas Sheriffs Association, and the Kansas Peace Officers Association. An officer of the Kansas Highway Patrol testified in support of the bill. No opponents testified on the bill.

The Senate Committee amended the bill to require exempt law enforcement vehicles to be clearly marked.

The fiscal note was not available at the time of passage of the bill.
