1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas highway patrol; allowing the
2 superintendent to charge and collect fees for certain services.
3

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) The superintendent of the Kansas highway patrol is
6 hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into contracts and charge and
7 collect fees for providing security and traffic patrol services at events held
8 by private entities where the superintendent determines the number of
9 people attending such event will have a significant impact on traffic and
10 law enforcement activities on state highways. Such fees shall be
11 negotiated in order to recover the expenses incurred in providing such
12 services by the Kansas highway patrol. The Kansas highway patrol shall
13 determine the amount of traffic patrol services and security necessary at
14 events held by private entities and shall set fees accordingly. This section
15 shall not apply to any event organized or operated by the state of Kansas or
16 a city, county or other political subdivision thereof.

17 (b) The Kansas highway patrol shall only negotiate, charge and
18 collect fees pursuant to this section when, in the opinion of the
19 superintendent, the expenses incurred to the highway patrol for providing
20 such security and traffic patrol services will exceed \$20,000.

21 (c) There is hereby created the highway patrol private security fund.
22 All moneys deposited into the highway patrol private security fund shall
23 be used only for the purpose of providing for security to private entities
24 pursuant to this section. All expenditures from the highway patrol private
25 security fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon
26 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to
27 vouchers approved by the superintendent or the designee of the
28 superintendent. All moneys received by the superintendent for such
29 services shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the
30 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be
31 credited to the highway patrol private security fund.

32 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
33 publication in the statute book.
