AN ACT concerning elections; relating to education of election workers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The secretary of state is hereby directed to develop a standardized, statewide, comprehensive training program on all statutes and rules and regulations for election workers, poll workers and other persons involved in an election and such persons who are expected to implement and enforce voter registration laws.

- (b) Such training program shall be in place before the August 7, 2012, primary election and shall include an objective means of testing and evaluating such trainee's knowledge of the statutes, rules and regulations and policies and procedures covered by such training. Trainees who do not demonstrate a sufficient understanding of the statutes, rules and regulations and policies and procedures shall either be retrained prior to assuming such trainee's duties or removed from such trainee's position.
- (c) All training materials, test results and evaluations shall be an open record for the purposes of K.S.A. 45-215 *et seq.*, and amendments thereto, and available for examination prior to any election.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
