1 AN ACT concerning capital improvement budget estimates; relating to
2 program and facilities plans for public safety agencies; amending
3 K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 75-3717b and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 75-3717b is hereby amended to read
7 as follows: 75-3717b. (a) Whenever a state agency proposes a capital
8 improvement project for the construction of a building or for major
9 repairs or improvements to a building, such state agency shall prepare a
10 capital improvement budget estimate to be submitted to the division of
11 the budget in such form as may be required by the director of the budget
12 and this section. Such state agency shall prepare and include as a part of
13 such capital improvement budget estimate a written program statement
14 describing the project. Such program statement shall: (1) Include a
15 detailed justification for the project including an analysis of the programs,
16 activities and other needs and intended uses for the additional or
17 improved space and an analysis of the alternative means by which such
18 space needs and uses could be satisfied; (2) request appropriations for the
19 project in the three phases of preliminary planning, final planning and
20 construction; (3) describe in detail each such phase of the project; and (4)
21 include cost estimates for land, site surveys, soil investigations,
22 equipment, buildings or major repairs or improvements to buildings and
23 other items necessary for the project.

24 (b) Not later than July 1 of each year, such state agency shall submit
25 to the division of the budget a copy of such capital improvement budget
26 estimate, and all amendments and revisions thereof, and at the same time
27 such state agency shall submit copies of such capital improvement budget
28 estimate, and all amendments and revisions thereof, directly to the state
29 building advisory commission and to the joint committee on state
30 building construction.

31 (c) On or before November 15 each year, the state building advisory
32 commission shall report and make recommendations on each capital
33 improvement budget estimate received pursuant to this section regarding
34 the project costs, projected scheduling of funding for such costs, and such
35 other matters as are deemed appropriate by the state building advisory
36 commission, to: (1) The division of the budget; (2) the joint committee on

1 state building construction; and (3) the legislative research department.

2 (d) Not later than July 1 of each year, each state agency submitting
3 such budget estimates shall prepare and submit to the division of the
4 budget, to the state building advisory commission and to the joint
5 committee on state building construction copies of a five-year capital
6 improvement program and facilities plan which shall set forth the current
7 and future space needs and utilization plans for the next five ensuing
8 fiscal years for that state agency in such form and containing such
9 additional information as prescribed by the secretary of administration,
10 *except that for each public safety agency, the capital improvement*
11 *program and facilities plan shall be for the next 15 ensuing fiscal years.*

12 (e) Except as provided in this subsection, the provisions of this
13 section do not apply to any capital improvement project for the adjutant
14 general that is funded entirely by moneys from the federal government.
15 During the month of January each year, the adjutant general shall present
16 a report to the joint committee on state building construction on all capital
17 improvement projects that are funded entirely by moneys from the federal
18 government and that are proposed for the current and ensuing fiscal
19 years.

20 (f) The provisions of this section do not apply to any capital
21 improvement project for Kansas correctional industries of the department
22 of corrections as provided in subsection (d) of K.S.A. 75-5282, and
23 amendments thereto.

24 (g) *As used in this section, "public safety agency" means the*
25 *department of corrections, including all state correctional institutions,*
26 *juvenile justice authority, including all state juvenile correctional*
27 *facilities, adjutant general, state fire marshal, Kansas parole board,*
28 *Kansas highway patrol, department of transportation, Kansas bureau of*
29 *investigation, emergency medical services board, Kansas sentencing*
30 *commission and Kansas commission on peace officers' standards and*
31 *training.*

32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 75-3717b is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
34 publication in the statute book.

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
