1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending
2 June 30, 2011, June 30, 2012, and June 30, 2013, for state agencies;
3 authorizing certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees,
4 imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or
5 authorizing certain receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the
6 foregoing.

8 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

9 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2011, June 30,
10 2012, and June 30, 2013, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and
11 limitations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement
12 projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing
13 are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

14 (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
15 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized by
16 this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to the
17 restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

18 (c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
19 K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.

20 (d) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the
21 provisions of K.S.A. 46-155, and amendments thereto.

24 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general
25 fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, for the capital improvement

19 *Provided*, That, the secretary of administration may accept gifts,
 20 donations and grants of money, including payments from local units of city
 21 and county government, for the development of a new master plan for the

 23 amendments thereto: *Provided further*, That all such gifts, donations and
 24 grants shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the
 25 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, to the credit of the
 26 capitol plaza area authority planning fund.

 41 balance as of June 30, 2011, in each of the following capital improvement
 42 accounts of the building and ground fund: Parking improvements and
 43 repair: *Provided*, That the expenditures for fiscal year 2011 from the

1 unencumbered balance of any such account shall not exceed the amount of
 2 the unencumbered balance in such account on June 30, 2011: *Provided*
 3 *further*, That all expenditures from the building and ground fund for the
 4 fiscal year 2012 from the unencumbered balance in any such account shall
 5 be in addition to any expenditure limitation imposed on the building and
 6 ground fund for the fiscal year 2012.

7 (e) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be
 8 made by the above agency from the state buildings depreciation fund for
 9 fiscal year 2012, expenditures may be made by the above agency from the
 10 following capital improvement account or accounts of the state buildings
 11 depreciation fund for fiscal year 2012 for the following capital
 12 improvement project or projects, subject to the expenditure limitations
 13 prescribed therefor:

- 14 State of Kansas facilities projects – debt service.....No limit
- 15 Rehabilitation and repair.....\$400,000

16 *Provided*, That all expenditures from each such capital improvement
 17 account shall be in addition to any expenditure limitation imposed on the
 18 state buildings depreciation fund for fiscal year 2012.

19 (f) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be
 20 made by the above agency from the state buildings depreciation fund for
 21 fiscal year 2012, expenditures may be made by the above agency from the
 22 state buildings depreciation fund for fiscal year 2012 from the
 23 unencumbered balance as of June 30, 2011, in each capital improvement
 24 account of the state buildings depreciation fund for one or more projects
 25 approved for prior fiscal years: *Provided*, That expenditures from the
 26 unencumbered balance in any such account shall not exceed the amount of
 27 the unencumbered balance in such account on June 30, 2011: *Provided*
 28 *further*, That all expenditures from any such account shall be in addition to
 29 any expenditure limitation imposed on the state buildings depreciation
 30 fund for fiscal year 2012.

31 (g) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be
 32 made by the above agency from the state buildings operating fund for
 33 fiscal year 2012, expenditures may be made by the above agency from the
 34 following capital improvement account or accounts of the state buildings
 35 operating fund for fiscal year 2012 for the following capital improvement

3 project or projects, subject to the expenditure limitations prescribed
4 therefor:

6 (i) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be
7 made from the intragovernmental printing service depreciation reserve
8 fund for fiscal year 2012, expenditures may be made by the above agency
9 from the following capital improvement account or accounts of the

11 2012 for the following capital improvement project or projects, subject to
12 the expenditure limitations prescribed therefor:

4 *Provided*, That the secretary of social and rehabilitation services is
5 hereby authorized to transfer moneys during fiscal year 2012 from the
6 rehabilitation and repair projects account to a rehabilitation and repair
7 account for any institution, as defined by K.S.A. 76-12a01 or 76-12a18,
8 and amendments thereto, for projects approved by the secretary of social
9 and rehabilitation services: *Provided further*, That expenditures also may
10 be made from this account during fiscal year 2012 for the purposes of
11 rehabilitation and repair for facilities of the department of social and
12 rehabilitation services other than any institution, as defined by K.S.A. 76-
13 12a01 or 76-12a18, and amendments thereto.

33 this fund during fiscal year 2012 of moneys made available to the state
34 under section 903(d) of the federal social security act, as amended, may be
35 made for the following capital improvement projects: (1) For rehabilitation
36 and repair of existing buildings used by the department of labor for
37 employment security purposes; (2) for paving, landscaping and acquiring
38 fixed equipment as may be required for the use and operation of such
39 buildings; or (3) for any combination of these purposes: *Provided further*,
40 That expenditures from this fund for fiscal year 2012 of moneys made
41 available to the state under section 903(d) of the federal social security act,
42 as amended, for such capital improvement purposes shall not exceed
43 \$40,000 plus the amounts of unencumbered balances as of June 30, 2011,

1 for capital improvement projects approved for fiscal years prior to fiscal
2 year 2012: *And provided further*, That all expenditures from this fund for
3 any such capital improvement purposes or projects shall be in addition to
4 any expenditure limitation imposed on the employment security
5 administration fund for fiscal year 2012.

6 (b) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following
7 special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, all
8 moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund or
9 funds, except that expenditures shall not exceed the following:
10 Employment security administration property sale fund.....No limit

11 *Provided*, That the secretary of labor is hereby authorized to make
12 expenditures from the employment security administration property sale
13 fund for the unemployment insurance program: *Provided, however*, That
14 no expenditures shall be made from this fund for the proposed purchase or
15 other acquisition of additional real estate to provide space for the
16 unemployment insurance program of the department of labor until such
17 proposed purchase or other acquisition, including the preliminary plans
18 and program statement for any capital improvement project that is
19 proposed to be initiated and completed by or for the department of labor
20 have been reviewed by the joint committee on state building construction.

21 (c) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be
22 made by the department of labor from moneys appropriated from any
23 special revenue fund for fiscal year 2012 as authorized by this or other
24 appropriation act of the 2011 regular session of the legislature,
25 expenditures may be made by the department of labor for fiscal year 2012
26 from the moneys appropriated from any special revenue fund for the
27 expenses of the sale, exchange or other disposition conveying title for any
28 portion or all of the real estate of the department of labor: *Provided*, That
29 such expenditures may be made and such sale, exchange or other
30 disposition conveying title for any portion or all of the real estate of the
31 department of labor may be executed or otherwise effectuated only upon
32 specific authorization by the state finance council acting on this matter,
33 which is hereby characterized as a matter of legislative delegation and
34 subject to the guidelines prescribed in subsection (c) of K.S.A. 75-3711c,
35 and amendments thereto, and acting after receiving the recommendations
36 of the joint committee on state building construction: *Provided, however*,
37 That no such sale, exchange or other disposition conveying title for any
38 portion of the real estate of the department of labor shall be executed until
39 the proposed sale, exchange or other disposition conveying title for such
40 real estate has been reviewed by the joint committee on state building
41 construction: *Provided further*, That the net proceeds from the sale of any
42 of the real estate of the department of labor shall be deposited in the state
43 treasury to the credit of the employment security administration property

1 sale fund of the department of labor: *And provided, further,* That
2 expenditures from such fund shall not exceed the limitation established for
3 fiscal year 2012 by this or other appropriation act of the 2011 regular
4 session of the legislature except upon approval of the state finance council.

18 Sec. 27. *Appeals to exceed expenditure limitations*. (a) Upon written
19 application to the governor and approval of the state finance council,
20 expenditures from special revenue funds may exceed the amounts
21 specified in this act.

19 Sec. 31. (a) Any Kansas educational building fund appropriation
20 heretofore appropriated to any institution named in this or other
21 appropriation act of the 2011 regular session of the legislature and having
22 an unencumbered balance as of June 30, 2011, in excess of \$100 is hereby
23 reappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, for the same use
24 and purpose as originally appropriated, unless specific provision is made
25 for lapsing such appropriation.

26 (b) This section shall not apply to the unencumbered balance in any
27 account of the Kansas educational building fund that was first appropriated
28 for any fiscal year commencing prior to July 1, 2010.

29 Sec. 32. (a) Any state institutions building fund appropriation
30 heretofore appropriated to any state agency named in this or other
31 appropriation act of the 2011 regular session of the legislature and having
32 an unencumbered balance as of June 30, 2011, in excess of \$100 is hereby
33 reappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, for the same use
