AN ACT concerning school crossing guards; amending K.S.A. 2013 Supp.
8-15,104 and repealing the existing section.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 8-15,104 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-15,104. (a) The governing body of any school district, 6 7 nonpublic school, city, township located in a county designated as an urban area pursuant to K.S.A. 19-2654, and amendments thereto, or 8 9 county is hereby authorized to appoint and equip volunteers and 10 designated designated employees of such school district, nonpublic school, city, township or county, and may provide training to such 11 12 volunteers and employees as school crossing guards, as defined in K.S.A. 13 2013 Supp. 8-1492, and amendments thereto, and is further hereby authorized to retain any other individual, firm, partnership, 14 15 corporation, public agency or other association of persons, by contract for services to direct traffic at school crossings, streets and highways in 16 the vicinity of schools and bus stops, by means of lawful orders, signs or 17 18 semaphores. Such persons shall wear a distinctive garb or insignia 19 indicating such appointment.

(b) School crossing guards shall not have the power to issue citationsor the power to arrest provided to law enforcement officers.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 8-15,104 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the Kansas register.
