AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to school safety and security policies and plans.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The board of education of each unified school district shall adopt a policy on school safety and security to protect students, teachers and other school employees on school property, in a school vehicle or at a school-sponsored activity or event.

- (b) The board of education of each unified school district shall adopt and implement a plan to address the protection of students, teachers and other school employees on school property, in a school vehicle or at a school-sponsored activity or event. Such plan shall require the school security officer designated as a school law enforcement officer pursuant to K.S.A. 72-8222, and amendments thereto, or if there is no school security officer, then the principal of such school or the principal's superintendent or the superintendent's designee, to annually meet with emergency medical responders or first responders and law enforcement agencies of the city or county in which the unified school district is located, to discuss such plan and the school safety and security policy of the unified school district.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
