1 AN ACT concerning lobbyists; regarding filings; amending K.S.A. 46-268
2 and repealing the existing section.
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4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 46-268 is hereby amended to read as follows: 46-
6 268. (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b), every lobbyist
7 shall file with the secretary of state a report of employment and
8 expenditures on a form and in the manner prescribed and provided by the
9 commission. A report shall be filed on or before the 10th day of the months
10 of February, March, April, May, September and January. Reports shall
11 include all expenditures which are required to be reported under K.S.A.
12 46-269, and amendments thereto, or a statement that no expenditures in
13 excess of \$100 were made for such purposes, during the preceding
14 calendar month or months since the period for which the last report was
15 filed.

16 (b) For any calendar year in which a lobbyist expects to expend an
17 aggregate amount of less than \$100 for lobbying in each reporting period,
18 a lobbyist shall file an affidavit of such intent with the secretary of state.
19 Such lobbyist shall not be required to file the reports required under
20 subsection (a) for the year for which such affidavit is filed ~~but shall file a~~
21 ~~report on or before January 10, which shall include all expenditures made~~
22 ~~in the preceding calendar year which are required to be reported under~~
23 ~~K.S.A. 46-269, and amendments thereto.~~ If in any reporting period a
24 lobbyist filing such affidavit expends in excess of \$100 in reportable
25 expenses, a report shall be filed for such period in the manner prescribed
26 by subsection (a).

27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 46-268 is hereby repealed.

28 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
29 publication in the statute book.
