1 AN ACT designating native American legislative day at the capitol;
2 amending K.S.A. 35-205 and repealing the existing section.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 35-205 is hereby amended to read as follows: 35-
6 205. (a) The fourth Saturday of September of the present year of our Lord
7 1945, and the fourth Saturday of September of each year thereafter is
8 hereby designated as "**Native** American ~~Indian~~ Day."

9 (b) *The first Wednesday of February of 2014, and the first Wednesday*
10 *of February of each year thereafter is hereby designated as "Native*
11 *American Legislative Day at the Capitol."*

12 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 35-205 is hereby repealed.

13 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
14 publication in the statute book.
