1 AN ACT concerning certain claims against the state, making
2 appropriations, authorizing certain transfers, imposing certain
3 restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain
4 disbursements, procedures and acts incidental to the foregoing.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

35 Sec. 10. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this act, the director of
36 accounts and reports is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants on
37 the state treasurer in favor of the claimants specified in this act, upon
38 vouchers duly executed by the state agencies directed to pay the amounts
39 specified in such sections to the claimants or their legal representatives or
40 duly authorized agents, as provided by law.

41 (b) The director of accounts and reports shall secure prior to the
42 payment of any amount to any claimant, other than amounts authorized to
43 be paid pursuant to section 9, and amendments thereto, as motor-vehicle

1 fuel tax refunds or as transactions between state agencies as provided by
2 this act, a written release and satisfaction of all claims and rights against
3 the state of Kansas and any agencies, officers and employees of the state of
4 Kansas regarding their respective claims.

5 Sec. 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
6 publication in the Kansas register.
